Introductory Prayers

+ Holy God, Holy Mighty, Holy Immortal, have mercy
on us! (3x)

+ Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy
Spirit, now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

O Most-holy Trinity, have mercy on us. Lord, cleanse
us from our sins. Master, pardon our transgressions.
Holy One, visit and heal our infirmities for Thy Name's
sake.

Prayers Before & After Meals

The usual Table Prayers are as follows:

+In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

The Lord's Prayer can be read or sung:

Amen. + Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be
Thy Name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done on
earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily
bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive
those who trespass against us. And lead us not into
temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

+ Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy
Spirit, now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Lord, have mercy! (3x) Father/mother, bless!

*The father or mother blesses the food with their right
hand in the form that we do when we cross ourselves.*

O Christ our God bless the food and drink of us Thy
servants, for Thou art holy always, + now and ever,
and unto ages of ages. Amen.

*An alternative prayer which replaces the Lord's Prayer
at dinner is from Psalm 22:26:*

The poor shall eat and be satisfied; those who seek
the Lord shall praise Him; their hearts shall live forever

The Thanksgiving Prayer (Tone 4):

+ We give thanks to Thee, O Christ our God, for Thou
hast satisfied us with Thine earthly blessings. Deprive
us not of Thy heavenly Kingdom, but as Thou camest
in the midst of Thy disciples and didst grant them
peace, so come to us and save us, O Savior!
